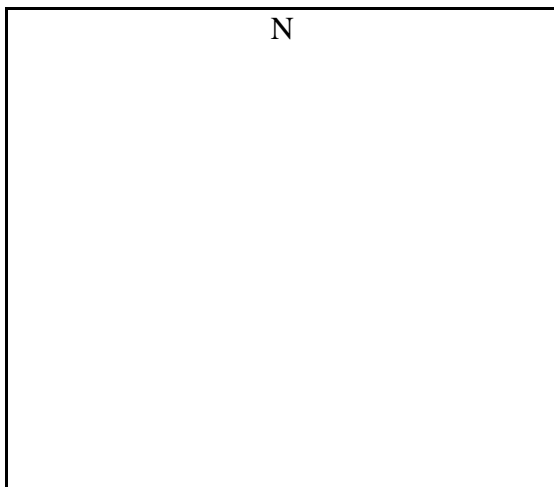

Terms and Conditions

Objectives:

- Crossing field waterways on unimproved crossings with machinery or by livestock can cause erosion and sedimentation.
- This program aims to improve water quality by stabilizing and restricting unimproved field crossings.

Eligibility and Conditions:

- Lands must be within the Intermountain Conservation District.
- Crossing must protect a waterway and be in a field and not on a road allowance.

Assistance:

- Funding for field crossings will be cost-shared in the ratio of 40% Applicant, and 60% Intermountain Conservation District at the discretion of the sub-district. Applicant must make a down payment of 50% of their estimated contribution prior to project being started.

General Information:

- All projects are to be approved by the IMCD prior to construction and are subject to available funding.
- The Conservation District shall determine application priority in consultation with Sub-district, Board and Staff.
- All necessary approvals will need to be in place prior to construction.
- Engineering and technical service and financial assistance for project design, construction and repairs will be subject to the availability of funding and/or staff. The Intermountain Conservation District reserves the right to establish priorities for providing such services and assistance.
- IMCD reserves the right for reasonable access to the project site for inspection and to promote the program
- Indemnify and save harmless the Intermountain Conservation District, their agents, engineers, servants and /or employees from any liability that may result from this project.
